BLUF and Agenda

Executive Summary:

All SCIP communities are transitioning from its current local Single-Sign On (SSO) to a Department of War (DoW) SSO. Legacy authentication mechanisms like RSA Tokens will be transitioned to ECA Certificates and other approved multi-factor authentication (MFA) capabilities.

Mandate:

All DoW systems are to migrate from their existing authentication and authorization systems to an approved DoW Identity Provider.

What this means:

- Different URL's
- You will see a different login screen, which is a picture of a dog wearing goggles (DOGGLES).
- Before you can request role-based access, you must first submit a DoW credential sponsorship request.
- Instead of submitting PDF forms, there will now be a web-based publicly accessible form.
- Once your access is approved, you will have instant access.

RSA Tokens

Current Status:

- There are ~660 active RSA Token Users across SCIP
- 400 of these are set to expire October 31, 2026.
- 420 ordered and will be mailed out as soon as possible
- 240 will expire April 29, 2027
- Will not renew training/test tokens

Planned Retirement:

- July 2027



External Certification Authority (ECA) Certificates

What is it:

An External Certification Authority (ECA) certificate is a DoD-approved digital credential that serves as the modern replacement for your legacy RSA token. You will use this certificate, either as software in your browser or on a physical smart card, to access DoW applications like the Security Cooperation Information Portal (SCIP).

Who is **NOT** Eligible:

- DoW CAC holders
- DoS PIV holders
- Australia/Canada/Netherlands PIV holders
- Current ECA holders



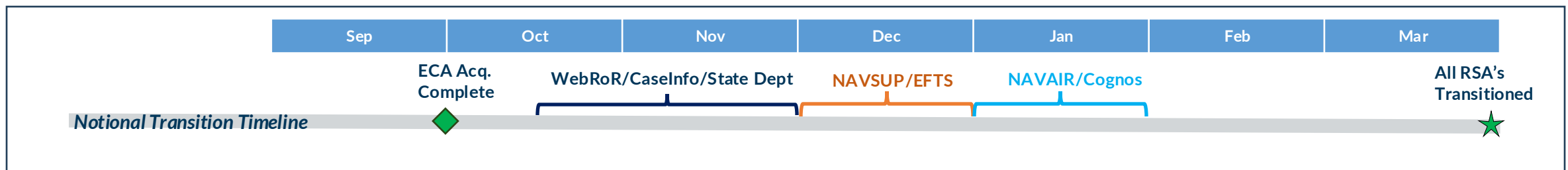

On-Site ECA Onboarding

Purpose:

During the conference, onsite support will be available help a limited amount of eligible international SCIP users begin ECA onboarding.

Who This is For:

- Foreign national users requiring ECA credentials for SCIP access
- Users who meet eligibility and documentation requirements
- Users able to complete online application steps during event

Required:

- Passport and one additional government-issued photo ID (can be from your country)
- Access to official email account
- Internet access to complete voucher redemption and online identity verification



On-Site ECA Onboarding con't

What will be provided onsite:

- ECA Vouchers
- IdenTrust Part 1 and Part 2 forms for wet signature
- Submission of digital copies of signed forms to IdenTrust
- Mailing of physical signed forms
- Physical smart cards for users receiving hard certificates / smart card loading support if certificate is issued in time

Important notes:

- Credential issuance timing may vary (can take 24-72 hours)
- Some users may receive soft certificates instead of hard certificates
- Hard certificate loading to smart card is only possible if issuance occurs quickly enough
